



Cookie Policy

We are deeply committed to maintaining the trust of our customers, therefore we believe it is important to explain, as clearly as possible, how and when we use cookies and similar technologies on our website to collect and use information. Some of the purposes for installing cookies may also require the User's consent, which can be revoked freely at any time.

COOKIE

Cookies are unique identifiers, normally composed of small portions of text or codes, which are sent from the website and stored by the internet browser on the user's computer or other device (for example, tablet or mobile phone), where they are stored to be then retransmitted to the same sites on the following visit by the same user.

By default, almost all web browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. Typically cookies can be installed:

- Directly by the owner and / or manager of the website (so-called first-party cookies);
- By managers unrelated to the website visited by the user (so-called third-party cookies). Unless otherwise specified, please note that these cookies fall under the direct and exclusive responsibility of the same manager. Further information on privacy and their use can be found directly on the websites of the respective operators.

PERMANENCE OF COOKIES ON DEVICES

Cookies are classified as "Session" or "Persistent."

The former are cookies that are not stored permanently on the user's computer and are deleted when the browser is closed, they are strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to allow the safe and efficient exploration of the site, avoiding the use of other IT techniques potentially prejudicial to the confidentiality of users' browsing. The latter are cookies that remain stored on the computer's hard drive until their expiration or cancellation by users / visitors. Through persistent cookies, visitors who access the site (or any other users who use the same computer) are automatically recognized at each visit.

COOKIES USED BY THE SITE

This website uses the following types of cookies classified according to the indications of the Privacy Guarantor and the Opinions issued at European level by the Working Group pursuant to art. 29 of the GDPR:

- First party:
 - Technical / Necessary, they are the cookies necessary for the transmission of communications on the electronic communications network or cookies strictly necessary for the supplier to provide the service requested by the customer. They are not used for other purposes and are installed directly by the website operator. The prior and informed consent of the user is not required for these types of cookies.



- Navigation or session, are the cookies that guarantee the normal navigation and use of the website;
- Statistical, they are cookies that collect information in aggregate form on the number of users and how they visit the site itself and are used directly by the site operator;
- Functional, they are cookies that allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, the language, the products selected for purchase);
- Third party:
 - *Google Analytics*: is a web analysis service provided by Google Inc. that uses the Personal Data collected for the purpose of tracking and examining the use of this Application, compiling reports and sharing them with other services developed by Google.

 - *Facebook Pixel*: is a service provided by Facebook Inc aimed at providing a series of advertising products such as offers in real time by third party advertisers and which allows visitors to be tracked within the site and to create remarketing lists. The interactions and information acquired are subject to the User's privacy settings relating to the social network.

DEACTIVATION OF COOKIES

The user can manage, or request the general deactivation or cancellation of cookies, by changing the settings of his/her internet browser and preventing - for example - third parties from installing them.

Through the browser preferences it is also possible to delete the cookies installed in the past, including the cookie in which the consent to the installation of cookies by this site is eventually saved. The settings to manage or disable cookies may vary depending on the internet browser used.
