



PRIVACY POLICY

We confirm our constant commitment to keep the data protected and to guarantee maximum transparency on the way in which it will be treated and kept safe. 1. THE BASIS

DEFINITIONS

Particular Data: personal data that reveal racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, as well as processing genetic data, biometric data intended to uniquely identify a person, data relating to health or sexual life or sexual orientation of the person.

Processing: any operation or set of operations, carried out with or without the aid of automated processes and applied to personal data or sets of personal data, such as the collection, registration, organization, structuring, conservation, adaptation or modification, extraction, consultation, use, communication by transmission, dissemination or any other form of making available, comparison or interconnection, limitation, cancellation or destruction.

Interested party: the natural or legal person to whom the personal data refers.



Data Processor: the natural or legal person, public authority, service or other body that processes personal data on behalf of the data controller.

Data Controller: the natural or legal person, public authority, service or other body which, individually or together with others, determines the purposes and means of processing personal data; when the purposes and means of such processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria applicable to its designation may be established by Union or Member State law.

Authorized Person: a natural person who processes personal data on behalf of the data controller.

User / Customer: any person who makes use of our services.

Visitor: any person who visits the websites.

Future contact: any person who joins the social data collection campaign

2. PRIVACY FOR VISITORS

PROCESSED DATA

Browsing data:

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, the addresses in URI / URL (Uniform Resource Identifier / Locator) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in the submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment.

STORAGE TIME

Personal data are kept for 24 months from the date on which the last consent was obtained.

3. PRIVACY CUSTOMERS / SCHOOL USERS

This section applies to personal data that we collect and process if you participate in our social campaigns aimed at promoting our business. If you are not a Member, the Visitors section may be the most suitable for you and your data.

PROCESSED DATA

The processing may concern data such as: Tax code and other personal identification numbers; Name, address or other elements of personal identification, Contact data (telephone number, e-mail, etc.), Bank details and Images.

PURPOSE

SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION OR DDIFFUSION

The data provided may be communicated to any consultants and freelancers in a single or associated form, to companies, as well as to credit institutions and insurance companies, also, subject to consent, they may be communicated to the Data Controller's business partners. In any case, all recipients of the data are still bound to respect the confidentiality referred to in the GDPR and a complete list of them may be requested from the Data Controller. Within the limits pertinent to the indicated processing purposes and subject to consent, personal data (images and audiovisual footage) may be communicated, published and / or disseminated in any form on the owner's websites, on the social channels of the same and / or on any other means of diffusion.

STORAGE TIME

Personal data for tax, accounting and direct purposes to resolve any disputes are kept for 10 years (art. 2220 and 2946 of the civil code), on the other hand the data collected for advertising and promotional purposes are kept for 24 months from the date on which the latest consent was obtained for this purpose.

4. GENERAL INFORMATION

DATA PROCESSING METHODS

Personal data are processed by the Data Controller and by authorized persons using manual, IT and telematic tools, for specific, explicit and legitimate purposes through the following methods: collection, registration, organization, conservation, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data. The Data Controller processes personal data by adopting the appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of the same.

PLACE OF TREATMENT

The data are processed at the Owner's headquarters and in any other place where the parties involved in the treatment are located.

TRANSFER OF EXTRA EU DATA

Personal data may be transferred to countries of the European Union and to third countries with respect to the European Union in the context of the purposes referred to in this statement. In this circumstance, the Data Controller ensures the adoption of adequate guarantees (Directive 95/46 / EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, on the adequacy of the protection offered by the EU-US Privacy Shield regime - Privacy Shield)

EXISTENCE OF AN AUTOMATED DECISION-MARKETING PROCESS

The processing of personal data is carried out without resorting to automated processes including profiling.



RIGHT OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

- right to ask the Data Controller for confirmation that personal data concerning him or her is being processed and in this case to obtain access to such data;
- right to obtain the correction or cancellation of data and the limitation of the processing that concerns him;
- right to object to the processing of data for reasons related to the particular situation, except in cases of mandatory processing of data expressly provided for by current laws;
- right, in case of consent for one or more specific purposes, to revoke this consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given before the revocation;
- right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data;
- right to obtain data portability and to request a copy.

The interested party can send the request to the Data Controller by return mail. In order to ensure that the aforementioned rights are not exercised by unauthorized third parties, the Data Controller may request to provide any further information necessary for the purpose.

DEFENSE IN COURT AND CHECKS

Your personal data may be used by the Data Controller in court or in the preparatory stages for its possible establishment for the defense against abuse. You declare that you are aware that the Data Controller may be required to disclose data upon request from public authorities.

CHANGES TO THE INFORMATION
